Completing and submitting the form

You need only fill in the information you deem necessary. For example, it is not required that you provide an alternate contact. We do require a contact email and phone number, and request a cell phone for onsite contact if necessary.

Typically only your email address or primary phone number is needed for web or site flyer publication purposes. (The site flyer may or may not include a merchant list, and in any case will be more restricted in what it can publish.)

Note that most fields can contain more characters than appear on screen. If you're submitting the form electronically, no problem. If you're using postal mail, you can put "overflow" information in the the Comments field, or attach an extra sheet.

When you have completed this form, you can save it on your computer. You can then email it to the merchant coordinator (note the button at the top right of the form) or by attaching the saved file.

You may also print out the file (only page one is necessary, obviously) and postal mail it to the merchant coordinator at the address above **or** you can include it with your mailed-in registration.

The earlier you send in the form, the earlier we can get your name visible on our web site! But we can't guarantee space after June 1, 2011.

Roam NOWM

Each year, to encourage the populace to visit our merchants, we sponsor a Roam NOWM Scavenger Hunt. The attendees are given a list of questions, one for each merchant. They must visit each merchant to get the answer to the question. (We'll get them into your tent - it's up to you to sell 'em.)

About the questions. So, think of a very cool, fun question. It can be about your or your business; or something you know about the SCA or the Middle Ages that most people don't know; or it can really be anything at all.

Whether or not you feel you are able to donate a prize, you will be included in the Scavenger Hunt, so please provide a question. If you don't provide a question, one will be prepared for you!

About the prizes. We ask that each merchant donate a prize, but it's **not a requirement** of merchanting. The prizes need not be costly. Obviously, the more cool prizes we can offer (and display) the more people will want to participate in the game.

Even if you are not able to donate a prize, please provide a question above - you will still be included in the Hunt.

If you choose to donate, and can identify the prize in advance, we will advertise it on the web site.

The prizes (with donor identified) will be on display at the Magic Carpet Kavehane during the day Saturday.

Any unclaimed prizes will be used for future prize drawings (giving due credit to the donor, of course).
